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**CLASS & SHOW FEES:**

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- Dressage Tests - \$35 (Classes 1 – 12)
- Combined Tests - \$50 (Classes 13 – 18)
- Dressage Seat Equitation - \$30 (Classes 19 – 20)
- Jumpers - \$25 (Classes 21 – 24)
- Office Fee - \$5
- Stabling - \$40 / night
- Late Fee - \$10 (Entry and payment received after 3-2-2020, 11:59pm)
- Guest Horse - \$20 plus Office Fee

**ENTERING THE SHOW:**

- Enter and pay by mailing the entry to Carol Freligh at 1621 Middendorf Rd., Hartsville, SC 29550 and include a check made out to Charleston Equestrian Center, LLC. Returned checks will incur a \$50 fee and the entry held until payment is received.
- Entry forms may also be scanned and emailed to [carol@scdcta.com](mailto:carol@scdcta.com).
- Payment can also be made through the VENMO app on your cell phone. Enter Jan-MPEC to submit your entry fees in VENMO.
- Entries received after the closing date (3/2/20) will be required to pay a \$10 late fee. Late entries will be accepted until 3/4/20 at noon. No refunds after the closing date (3/2/20).
- Entries (mailed or emailed) will only be accepted if a current negative Coggins Report is attached and payment is received by the closing date (3/2/20); or late fee included if received by 3/4/20, 12:00:00 PM.
- Organizers reserve the right to refuse any entry. Organizers can combine, cancel, change or split classes and change show officials without notification to entrants.

**Awards:**

- All classes will be separated into Seniors and Junior/Young Riders if there are at least 3 or more riders in the class and First through Sixth place ribbons will be awarded.
- A Dressage High Score Prize & Ribbon will be awarded to the SCDCTA Member / SCDCTA Reg. Horse Pair with the highest score (Classes 1 through 12). A Combined Training Low Score Prize & Ribbon will be awarded to the SCDCTA Member / SCDCTA Reg. Horse Pair with the lowest score (Classes 13 through 18). **Stabling:** Contact Jan Taylor at [jan.mpec@gmail.com](mailto:jan.mpec@gmail.com) or 843-735-0709 to reserve. Cost for a stall is \$40/night, which includes shavings and cleaning. Stabling fee should be included when paying entry fees.

**Attire:** An ASTM Approved helmet must be worn AT ALL TIMES when mounted and footwear should have a distinguishable heel while riding. Otherwise, casual attire is acceptable.

**Arenas:** One (20m x 60m) dressage arena will be used for Classes 4-12 and 19-20. One (20m x 40m) dressage arena will be used for Classes 1-3 and 13-18. A separate jumping arena will be used for combined tests and jumpers.

**Guest Horses:** Horses **NOT** entered in classes but attending the show must have a completed entry form (for each horse) by the closing date (3/2/20) and a current negative Coggins Report included. The Liability clause must be signed by rider/handler of the horse on the entry form. The fees for each guest horse are \$20.00 and a \$5.00 office fee. Each guest horse is required



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to wear a number when off the trailer or out of a stall. The number is obtained at the Check-in Table. Late fees apply if requested after 3/4/20.

**Ride Times:** Dressage and jumping times will be posted on the Middleton Place Equestrian Center Facebook site and emailed to the email address on the entry form by Friday, 3/6/20 at noon. **MPEC April 2020 Championship Schooling Show – SUNDAY, APRIL 19, 2020:**

All competitors are welcome to show their horses in the regular classes normally offered at Middleton Place Equestrian Center during the MPEC April 2020 Championship Schooling Show. Horse/Rider Pairs that are **eligible for championship classes** will be notified by email by the opening date of the show, March 13, 2020. Championship classes will be listed separately.

**Eligibility requirements:**

- Participation in three of the four shows qualifies a rider/horse pair to compete in the MPEC April 2020 Championship Schooling Show classes scheduled for April 19, 2020.
- Rider and horse must show as a pair throughout the MPEC show series. Show dates are 9/21/2019, 11/23/2019, 1/18/2020, & 3/7/2020.
- A rider/horse pair can compete and become eligible in both Dressage and Combined Training.
- A rider/horse pair may only compete in the Championship class(es) for which they are eligible based upon the level(s) shown at the MPEC Show Series (9/21/19, 11/23/19, 1/18/20, and 3/7/20).
- Championship classes will be separated into Jr/YR and Senior divisions and include Introductory through Fourth Level Dressage Tests and Amoeba through Training Combined Tests.

**Competing:**

- The Championship classes for each Dressage level will be a separate class. Championship classes will be as follows:
  - Introductory C (3c – Jr/YR and 3d – Sr)
  - Training Level Test 3 (6c – Jr/YR and 6d – Sr)
  - First Level Test 3 (9c – Jr/YR and 9d – Sr)
  - Second Level Test 3 (10c – Jr/YR and 10d – Sr)
  - Third Level Test 3 (10c – Jr/YR and 11d – Sr)
  - Fourth Level Test 3 (11c – Jr/YR and 11d – Sr)
- The Championship classes for each Combined Training level will be a separate class. Championship classes will be as follows:
  - Amoeba (13c– Jr/YR and 13d – Sr)
  - Tadpole (14c– Jr/YR and 14d – Sr)
  - Beginner Novice (15c– Jr/YR and 15d – Sr)
  - Novice (16c– Jr/YR and 16d – Sr)
  - Training (17c- Jr/YR and 17d – Sr)
- Non-championship classes will also be offered and all competitors may enter these classes in addition to Championship classes. Eligibility requirements are applied as stated above for the specified Championship Classes.

**Awards:**

- Champion, Reserve Champion and 3<sup>rd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place ribbons will be awarded. Trophies/awards are TBD.
